City of Syracuse Lead Ordinance

- Under the new Lead Ordinance, City Code Inspectors are now able to cite for lead violations. This is primarily done through visual inspections in high-risk areas.
- If hazards are found, homeowners will be required to abate violations.
- If interior visual violations are found, additional testing will be required by the homeowner.
- All lead paint renovations must be completed by an EPA certified contractor or firm.

City of Syracuse Lead Ordinance Cont.

- Lead dust-wipe samples are required as part of clearance exams for interior violations.
- City inspectors will perform visual clearance for exterior and common area violations.
- Homeowners with units in the “High Risk Areas” are required to submit dust-wipe sample results within 60 days of a visual inspection (where no potential hazards were seen).
- Clearance reports, and dust-wipe samples that pass, are valid for 3 years unless a new hazard arises.

Lead Hazard Reduction Program

Homeowners, renters, and landlords may be eligible if you live in, or own, or rent a home that:

- Is in the City of Syracuse limits
- Has hazards from lead-based paint
- Was built before 1978
- Was designed for 1 to 4 families

Applicants must:

- Have a child under age 6 who lives in, or spends a significant amount of time, in the home
